

# Chicago Flute Club 2010 Walfrid Kujala Piccolo Artist Competition

## ELIGIBLE SOLOISTS AND COMPETITION REGULATIONS

The Chicago Flute Club Walfrid Kujala Piccolo Artist Competition is open to all piccolo players age 18 years or older, from any geographical area.

- The application fee is \$40 and is non-refundable.
- All application materials must be postmarked by September 15, 2010.
- High school students are ineligible.
- Current students of the final round judges are ineligible.
- The first place winner of the competition will be awarded \$1,000.00, the second place winner will be awarded \$500.00, and the third place winner will be awarded \$250.00.
- The preliminary round will be recorded and recordings will not be returned.
- Five finalists and one alternate will be notified by October 1, 2010.
- The five finalists will perform in-person with an accompanist for the final round.
- Finalists are responsible for their own travel arrangements and expenses.
- The final performance round is open to the public.
- Final round contestants must provide their own accompanist. The Chicago Flute Club can provide you with contact information for a local accompanist if necessary.
- All judges' decisions are final.

## REPERTOIRE

### *Preliminary Round*

1. Vincent Persichetti, *Parable XII Op. 125 for Solo Piccolo*
2. Antonio Vivaldi, *Piccolo Concerto in C, RV 444 Mvt. I and II* (with repeats, using the edition of your choice).

Applicants must submit **two unedited recordings** of the preliminary round selections on CD in the given order. No identifying information should appear on the CD face or packaging. Recordings will be coded and reviewed by a judging committee.

### *Final Round*

Finalists will play for a maximum total time of 20 minutes each (including time between movements and works). Final round repertoire of the applicant's choice must be submitted at the time of application. Applicants will be bound by these selections. Final round repertoire may not include preliminary round works.
