

The Chicago Flute Club Annual Student Competition

Sunday, November 14, 2010, 9:00 am to 7:30 pm

Eligibility and Contest Rules:

The competition is open to any flute player who is a student of a Chicago Flute Club member. Previous first-prize winners are not eligible to compete again in the same division. Senior Division students must be in grades 12 & under for the 2010-2011 school year and will perform in the preliminary round between 9:00 am and 5:00 pm. Junior Division students must be in grades 9 & under for the 2010-2011 school year and will perform in the preliminary round late-morning until 5:00 pm. Elementary Division must be in grades 6 & under for the 2010-2011 school year and will perform between 9:00 am and late-morning.

Application must be postmarked by October 16, 2010. There will be a \$15 fee for late entries if they are accepted. Both student and teacher must be current CFC members. Dues may be enclosed with application. Membership dues are non-refundable. Teacher or parent/guardian MUST volunteer on the day of the competition or student will be disqualified. It will be the student's or parent's responsibility to verify information on the notice sent to them by the CFC Contest Coordinator. Time requests should be made in writing with the application explaining the need for a certain time, but there is no guarantee a specific time can be accommodated. A confirmation letter or email with assigned times for the performer and for the volunteer will be sent two weeks before the competition. Contestants who decide not to compete should notify Jan Frank by October 16, 2010 to allow for necessary schedule changes. The application fee of \$25—made payable to the Chicago Flute Club—will be refunded only if the cancellation is received on or before October 16, 2010.

MEMORIZATION IS REQUIRED for the Junior Division *Pan!* by Donjon and the Senior Division *Canzone* by Barber. Elementary Division does not require memorization although extra credit may be given for memorizing. A time limit will be strictly enforced. You must use the editions specified. The competition may be limited to the first 20 Elementary applicants, the first 30 Junior applicants, and the first 40 Senior applicants. Contestants must provide their own accompanists for all pieces. Elementary Division winners will be announced after all the participants have performed (mid to late morning).

Junior and Senior Finalists will be announced after all participants have performed, around 5:00. The Finalists' Recitals for the Junior and Senior Divisions will be held at approximately 5:30 that same day and place. Any contestant who is not present for the Finalists' Recital cannot be considered for an award. One original copy of each finalist's recital repertoire must be presented to judges.

Judging is based on technical proficiency, musical style, and interpretation. The judges will determine the number of finalists. Participants not complying with the above rules will be disqualified. Judges' comments will be sent to teachers.

ELEMENTARY DIVISION REPERTOIRE -

Bergamask by Koepke, Concert and Contest Collection, with repeat and coda

Menuett by Kuhlau, Pearls of the Old Masters, vol. 2, take DC

Memorization not required for either piece. There will be no finalists' round for elementary division.

JUNIOR DIVISION REPERTOIRE - Preliminary Competition:

Pan! by Donjon, Concert and Contest Collection, must be memorized

Legend Pastorale by Godard, Selected Flute Solos, Published by Anasco

Junior Division: Finalists' Recital -- 9-11 minute program - a minimum of 2 pieces of contrasting styles chosen by each individual finalist. Repertoire from the preliminary round may be repeated. **Finalist's Recital will be held at approximately 5:30 at the conclusion of preliminary competition.**

SENIOR DIVISION REPERTOIRE - Preliminary Competition:

Canzone by Barber, G. Schirmer edition, must be memorized

Andante Pastorale & Scherzettino by Taffanel, Flute Music by French Composers

Senior Division: Finalists' Recital -- 12-15 minute program - a minimum of 2 pieces of contrasting styles chosen by each individual finalist. Repertoire from the preliminary round may be repeated. **Finalist's Recital will be held at approximately 5:30 at the conclusion of preliminary competition.**

AWARDS:

Elementary Division: 1st Prize - \$50, 2nd Prize - \$25; Junior Division: 1st Prize - \$100, 2nd Prize - \$75, 3rd Prize - \$50; Senior Division: 1st Prize - \$300 & \$100 Stolper Performers Music Scholarship, 2nd Prize - \$200, 3rd Prize \$100. The CFC Membership Chair will verify membership status of the contestant and the teacher. Teacher and student must be current members of the CFC for the application to be accepted. Dues for the 2010-11 year are \$20 for students and \$35 for active members. Dues include the CFC newsletter, *Pipeline*, and free or discounted admission to all programs for member and one guest.
